Requirements

- Java JRE 1.6+ (already installed)
- MeetingPoint Server 1.0+
- Moodle 1.9+
- Moodle MeetingPoint Module 1.0+
- a web server (already installed with PHP support)

Setup

MeetingPoint Server 1.0+

1. Download the latest version of MeetingPoint Server from [1] (Figure 1).

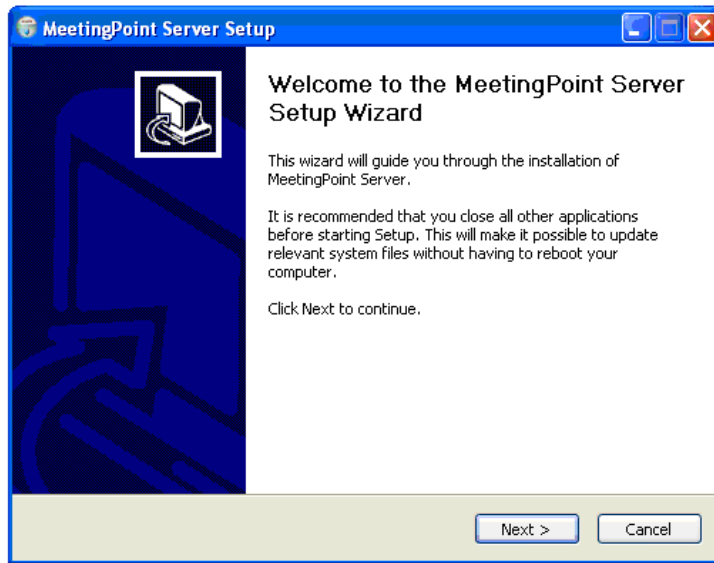


Figure 2: Installer welcome

2. Execute the installer (e.g. MeetingPoint-Server-1.0.exe, Figures 2-10).

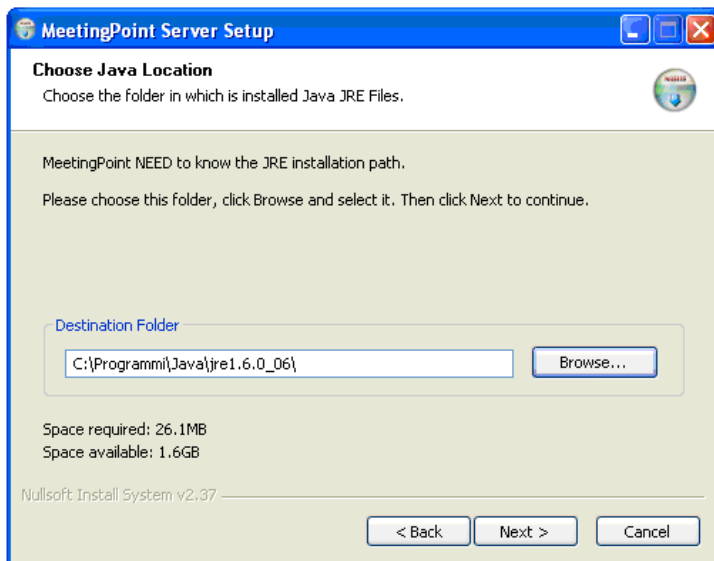


Figure 3: Java JRE installation path (REQUIRED)

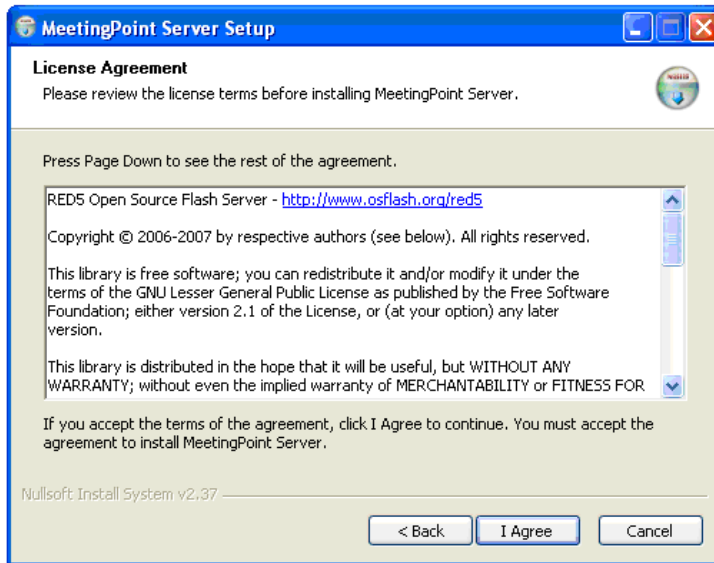


Figure 4: Red5 Server License

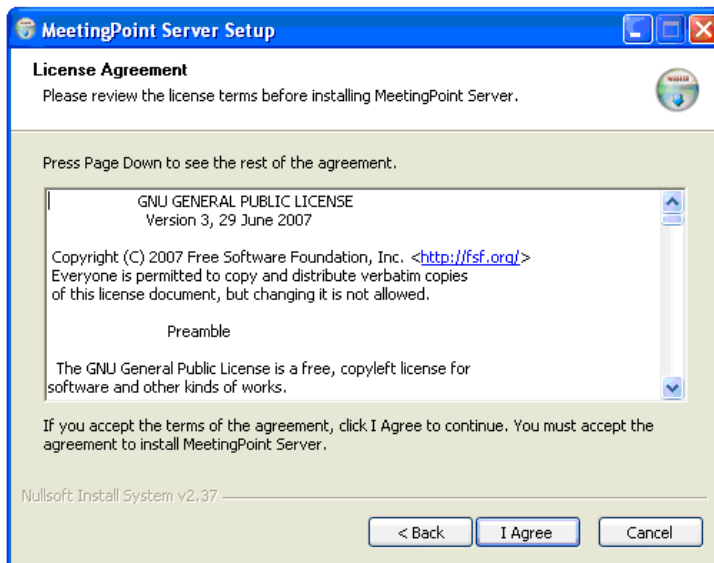


Figure 5: MeetingPoint Server License

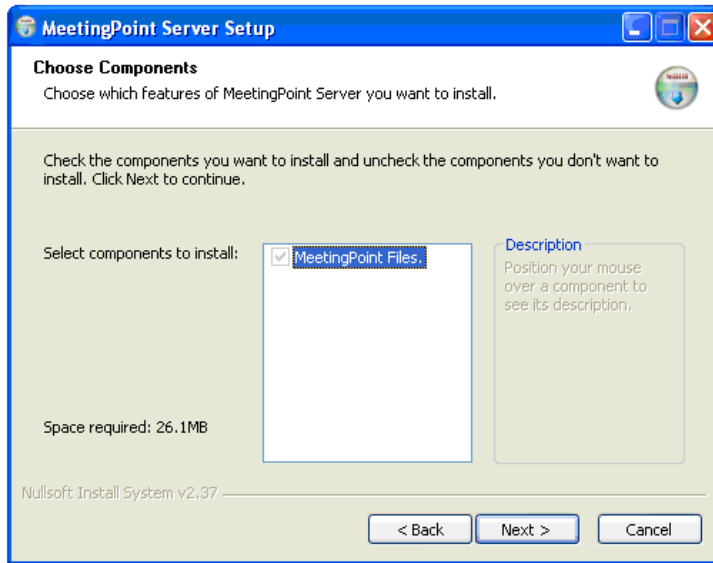


Figure 6: Customize installed package (now only one)

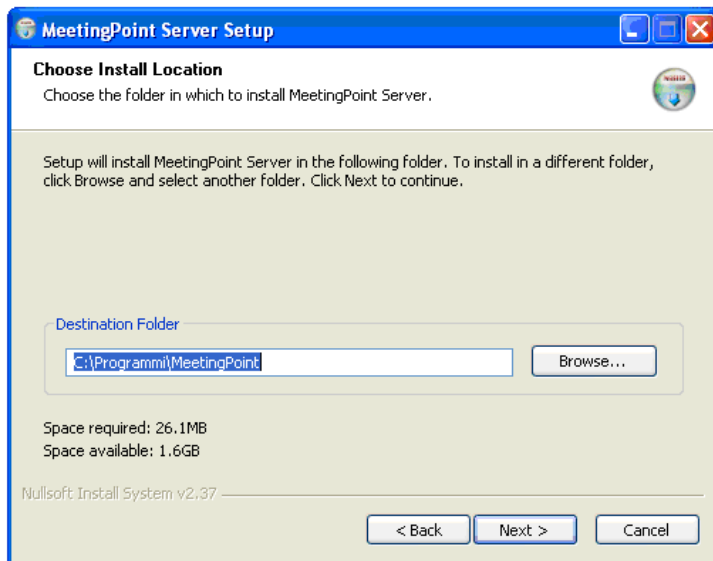


Figure 7: Select MeetingPoint Server installation path

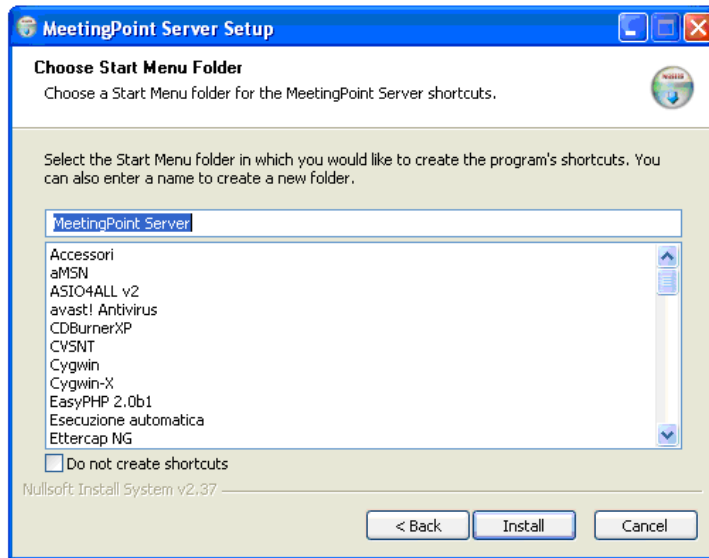


Figure 8: Select Start Menu Shortcuts path

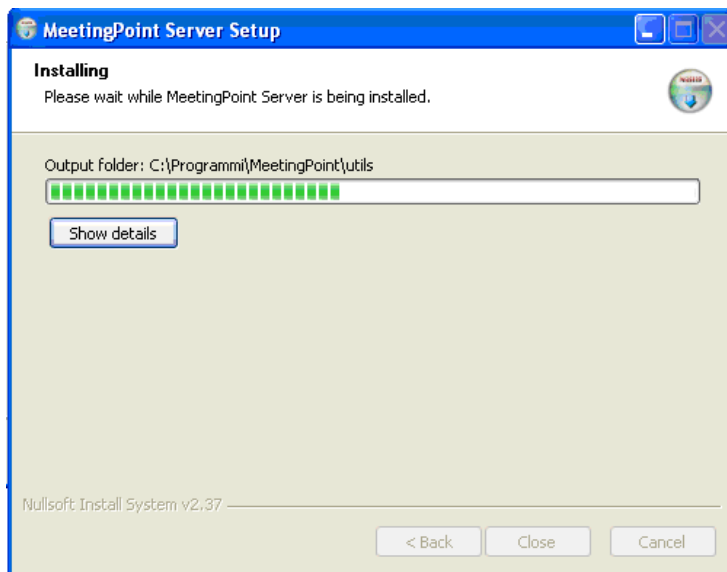


Figure 9: Install

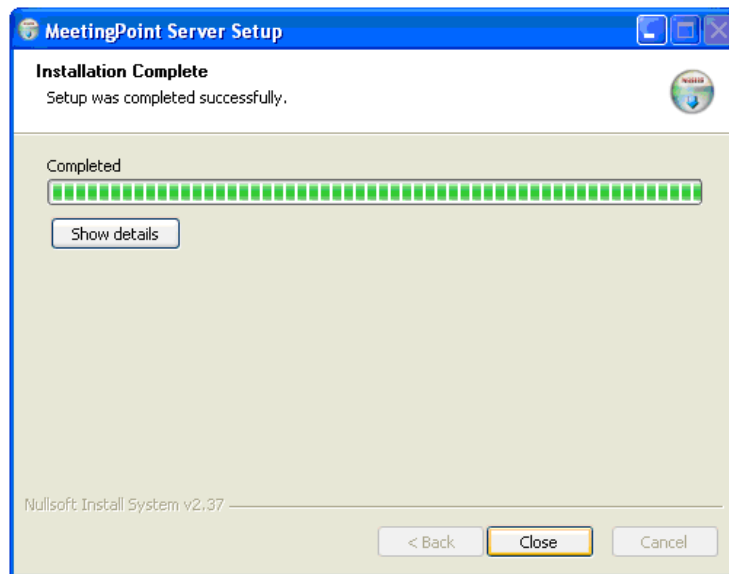


Figure 10: Installation Complete

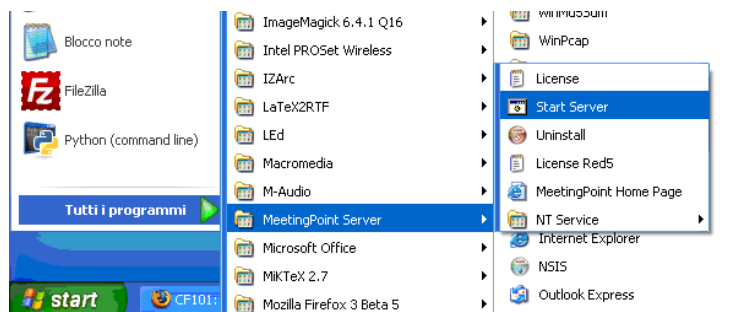


Figure 11: Start MeetingPoint Server

3. Start MeetingPoint Server (Figure 11).

Moodle 1.9+

1. Download Moodle from the official site [2].

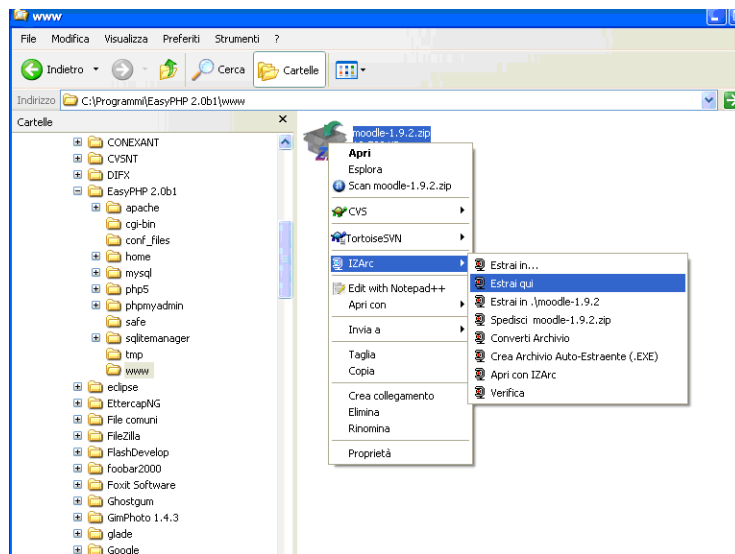


Figure 12: Unzipping Moodle in the web server root

2. Unzip Moodle in the Web Server root, as shown in Figure 12.

Moodle MeetingPoint Module 1.0+

1. Download the latest version of Moodle MeetingPoint Module from [1] (Figure 13).

2. Unzip Moodle MeetingPoint Module in mod directory of the Moodle's installation path.

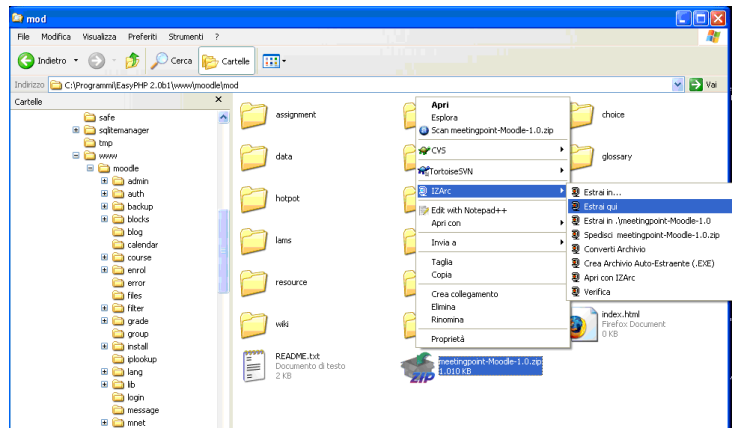


Figure 14: Unzipping Moodle MeetingPoint Module...

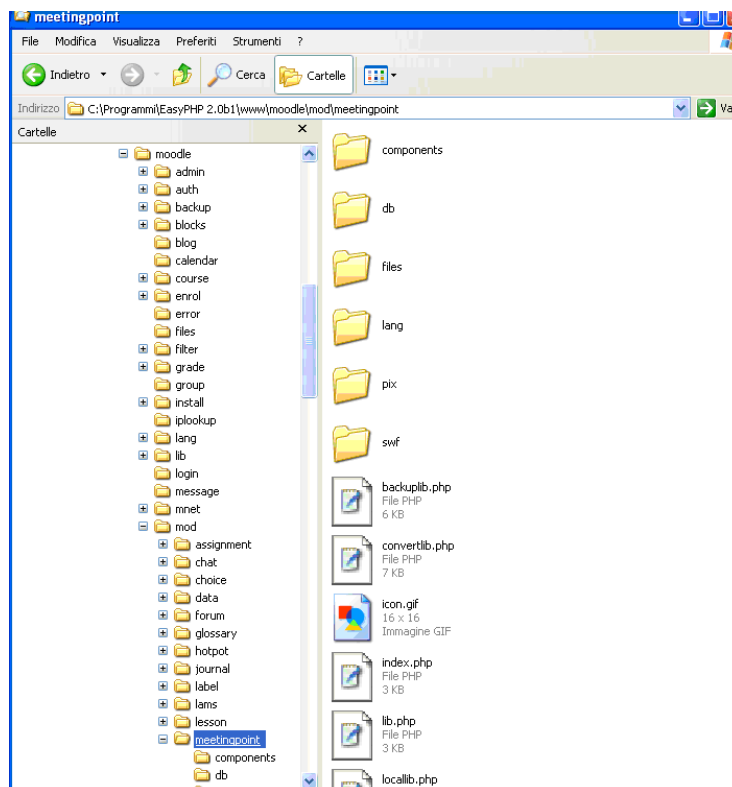


Figure 15: Directory listing

The directory listing may look like in Figure 15.

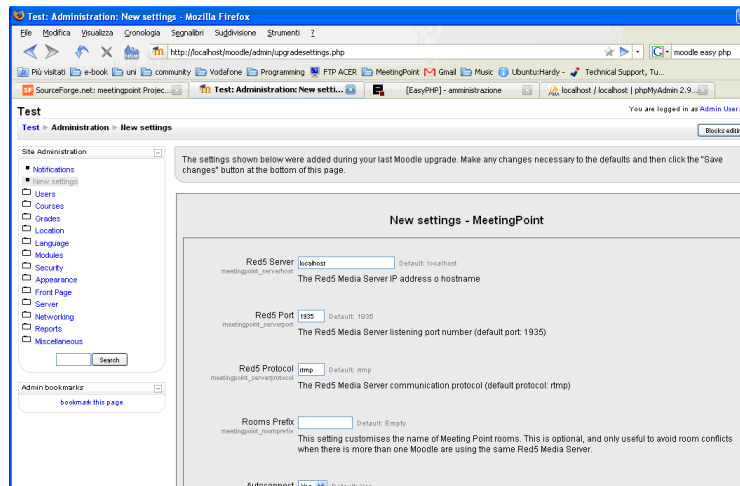


Figure 16: Moodle MeetingPoint Module configuration

3. Proceed to the usual Moodle installation and then configure the MeetingPoint Module (Figure 16).

The system is now correctly installed.

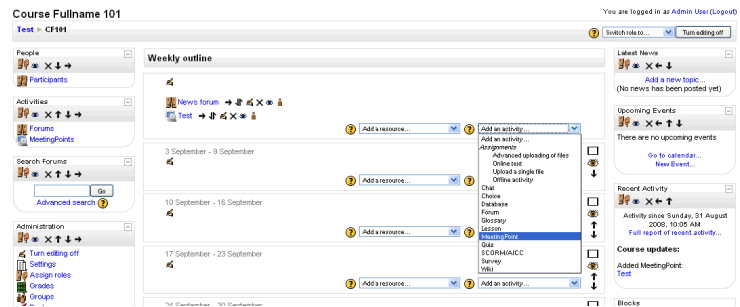


Figure 17: Adding a new MeetingPoint resource

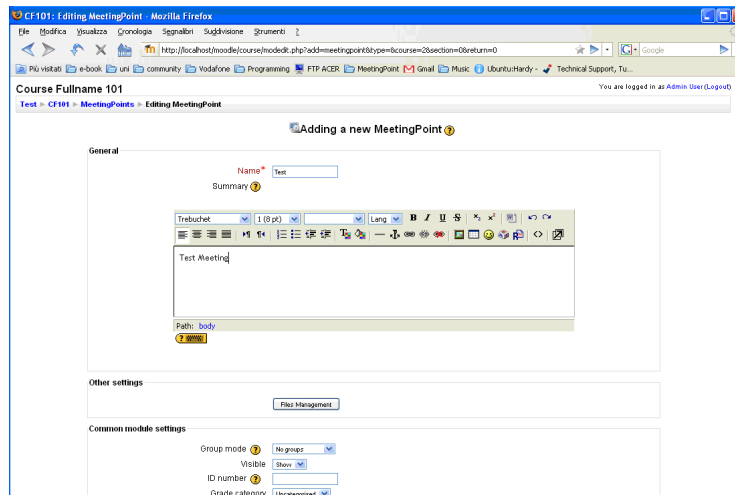


Figure 18: MeetingPoint module settings

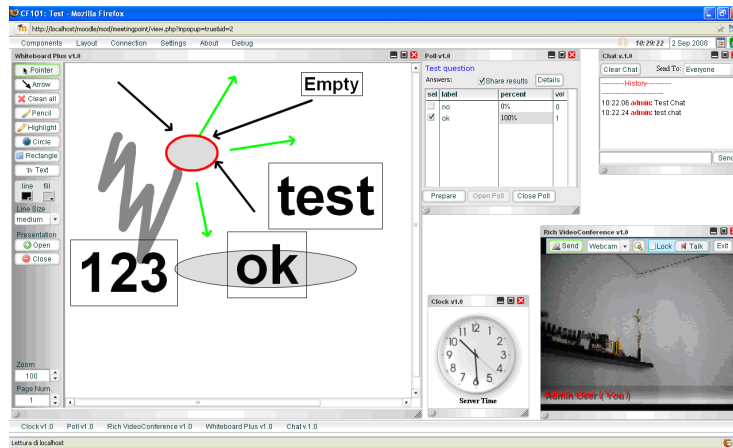


Figure 20: The MeetingPoint application running

You can test the installation by adding a new MeetingPoint resource (Figure 17, Figure 18 and Figure 19) and starting a conference (Figure 20).
